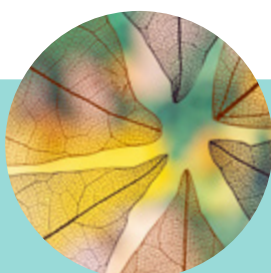

SUPPORT IN DRAWING UP A STRATEGIC PLAN FOR THE BLUE ECONOMY IN SAINT-MARTIN



Saint-Martin's Blue Economy strategy covers all maritime and coastal sectors, as well as sea-related innovation.

It covers the issues in a transversal and cross-sectoral way, integrating the environment, biodiversity, governance, training and youth employment, in the blue sectors but also territorial identity and the promotion of awareness and resilience of the island in the face of climate change.

An action plan with monitoring indicators has been drawn up using a graphic charter specific to Saint-Martin.

The team organised the «Premières assises de l'économie bleue de Saint-Martin», bringing together all the players and stakeholders.

PUBLIC/PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP (PPP) FOR THE PRODUCTION OF SUGARCANE WITH A SUGAR FACTORY IN MAURITANIA

In collaboration with DGACTA and COMASUD, the study focuses on setting up and structuring a PPP for the creation of an irrigated sugar cane area and the construction of a sugar factory in Mauritania.

As a project management team, the team provides support in structuring the PPP in technical, agronomic, legal, contractual and financial terms.



REHABILITATION OF 700 HUMAN-POWERED WATER POINTS IN RURAL AREAS WITH SOLAR PUMPS IN CÔTE D'IVOIRE



We have supported this project in rural areas on behalf of ONEP/MH and are assisting with its technical, social, organisational, legal and financial implementation in order to provide sustainable access to drinking water in rural areas, while reducing human hardship.

Services : Project management assistance for the refurbishment of the PMH; Study for the choice of management method; and Project management assistance for the transfer to delegated management by public-private contract (AMO).

The challenge of the project was also to implement a system of water can pricing and revenue collection in consultation with the communities, in particular the women who are the «water guardians».
